PRAY TOGETHER	MATTHEW 18:19-20 (NIV) Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.
INVEST IN RELATIONSHIP	PROVERBS 5:18 (NIV) May your fountain be blessed, and may you rejoice in the wife of your youth.
MAINTAIN PERSPECTIVE	LUKE 10:40 (NIV) But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to him and asked, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!"
PRESENT A UNITED FRONT	MATTHEW 12:25 (NIV) Jesus knew their thoughts and said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself will be ruined, and every city or household divided against itself will not stand.
SEEK GODLY SUPPORT	LUKE 5:18-19 (NIV)  Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus.
PRACTICE GRATITUDE	PHILIPPIANS 4:8 (NIV) Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.
LAUGH MORE	PROVERBS 15:15 (NIV) All the days of the oppressed are wretched, but the cheerful heart has a continual feast.
REMEMBER LOVE'S SOURCE	JOHN 3:16 (NIV) For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
